SANCERRE BLANC « La Côte des Monts Damnés »

TERROIR: Kimmeridgian marls

BEST SERVED AT: 10-12°C (50-53°F)

AGEING POTENTIAL: 6 to 9 years



VITICULTURE & TERROIR

- The vines are cultivated on a terroir of **Kimmeridgian marls** composed of thousands of small comma-shaped oyster shells (*ostrea virgula*)
- The Côte des Monts Damnés is one of the most famous and oldest cultivated hillsides of the Sancerre region (11th century); **it is south-facing and overlooks Chavignol**, the village of the Famille Bourgeois
- Voluntarily low yields, with a **high density cultivation** and **grassing** of the inter-rows
- Use of **organic fertilizers** only

WINEMAKING

- **Hand-picked** and transported to the winery across the valley with the utmost care
- **Slow and gentle pressing** to preserve the aromatic potential of the grapes
- Cold **settling** (8°C) and natural clarification of the must
- **Alcoholic fermentation** in temperature-controlled **stainless steel vats** between 59 and 64°F
- **Maturation** in vats on fine lees of fermentation for 9 months

PAIRING

This wine is a partner of choice for high level cuisine; it reveals itself with white meats, fish, or mature cheeses.

- *A famous Crottin de Chavignol.*

TASTING

Eye	Pale gold
Nose	Aromas of great finesse, slightly exotic
Palate	Clear, mineral, fruity and delicate - gains in fatness and complexity after 3 to 5 years of ageing

A nose of great finesse with exotic notes and a clean, mineral, fruity but not exuberant mouth. The direct and delicate expression of one of the most beautiful places of the Sancerre appellation.
